My dear Sir,

In revising and re-writing our Report on Southern New Brunswick I have thought it might be well to introduce in it a list of the coal plants obtained from the new locality in Sunbury County and of which specimens were some months ago forwarded to Montreal and I believe submitted to your inspection. As the Report is now nearly complete I write to inquire whether you have had leisure to bestow any attention upon them, and if so, whether you will kindly furnish me with a list of the species recognized.

I take also this opportunity of saying that in a recent letter from Mr. Paisley

that gentleman informs me that the fossil fish about which you inquired some time since and which was supposed to have been found at New Brandon did not really come from there, but from the Canada side of the Restigonche.

The re-writing of our report has been a great labor for me, but is now nearly done, and will I think be preferable to that first presented.
