CONCLUDING MEETING OF DELEGATES.

The delegates met on Monday forenoon when a motion was made and carried to reconsider the previous resolution regarding the

EDUCATIONAL READJUSTMENT SCHEME.

Thereafter a scheme was submitted of readjustment of the Queen's College and the Theological Halls, viz.:-

1st.—It is recommended that the Presbyterian Church of Scotland shall fully endow the Faculty of Arts in Queen's College from funds now available or from funds to be raised for the purpose.

2nd.—That tutorial work in relation to literary and scientific studies of students for the ministry, be not carried on in connexion with the Theological Institution of the United Church in Ontario and Quebec, but that facilities be afforded by the United Church in this respect in Queen's College, Kingston, and in Morin College, Quebec.

3rd.—That the Theological Departments of Queen's College and of Morin College, and the Presbyterian College of Montreal, shall be united into one College situated at Montreal.

4th.—That the Theological Department of Queen's College thus formed at Montreal shall be governed in accordance generally with the provisions of the charter of the Presbyterian College, Montreal.

5th.—That the three Theological Colleges of the United Church, viz. at Halifax, Montreal and Toronto, shall be affiliated with Queen's College so as to be represented in the University Senate.

1st. For conferring degrees in Divinity.

2nd. For taking such share in the Government of the University as may be proper in relation to the preparatory training of students for the University.

6th. That the present Principal of Morin College shall be invited to be the first Principal of the Theological College at Montreal, and that another Professor shall be invited from Queen's College, and in the event of his declining another Theological Professor shall be nominated by the Presbyterian Church in connexion with the Church of Scotland.

7th. That the necessary legislation shall be sought to bring Queen's University into the same relation to the United Church, in which it now stands to the Synod in connexion with the Church of Scotland, as well as to bring the other institutions into similar relations to the United Church.

The above resolutions were discussed and adopted.

The Committee then adjourned.
