Are you to be in the States soon? If you are make my home your home.

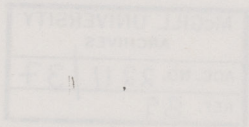
I myself is doing half work to our great delight. We had a course pictorial from Waterhouse Hawkins - very lively - but we had to keep a professor to prevent disorder
