To Mr Priuross

(Dear Sir

I was not able
for to do anything of the Prospecting
for Dr Dawson untill the last of
last week owing to my sore foot
but since that I attended diligen-
tly. I succeeded in tracing the
ore bed acrop Sutherlands River
from Webster's nearly to French
River - at John W. Fraser's on
the shore of Sutherlands River
about $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles from Webster's and
due East, is a very good exposure
more than 40 feet is bare, and for
one quarter of a mile and 400 yds
wide, the surface is covered with
Iron ore boulders so much so that
I supose there are many thousand
tons ^{on} the surface. I purpose going
tomorrow South of Webster and
East of Blauehard
