Gentlemen

I wrote and called you  
as to cost & freight of 100 tons  
of ore but have no reply.

Charter for Railway, to con-  
nect Iron deposits with Provincial  
R.R. Will you see that the pro-  
per notice is given so that we  
may obtain an act at next  
Parliament for the constructi-  
on of the road. The power so  
should be ample & a grant  
of land as bonus asked for.  
Mr. Rigby told us that this  
might be obtained from the  
Government

Mining Act. You are aware  
that this was amended so as to  
make Iron leases renewable  
the same as coal leases. This  
amended act was not in print  
when I was in Nova Scotia  
and it has never been sent  
to me. Without it I cannot  
verify the statement in <sup>my</sup> ~~any~~  
prospectus that the lease will  
be renewed. Please send me  
three copies immediately.
