topography as to the general con-
fession of the change readily
in the form of the survey,

line was marked on the ground
by four points and of a dug-quack
ground land survey, it is my
opinion that the present report should
have mentioned it and that
if it cannot do so it should in some
way make good as to the right
being to the company.
