On the coral-reef off Mauritius I have found a new Foraminiferous Rhizopod, the structure of which is very simple, therefore I was induced to make studies regarding the structure of several other Foraminifers and also the structure of *Eozoon canadense*. For many preparations of this I am very indebted to Mess. Carpenter, Credner, Hochstetter, Hahn and others. But because I am not yet undoubtedly convinced, that the structure

of Cozoon be organic,
I would be very glad,
to get some slices from
your hand, which show
distinctly the organic
structure and also
a specimen of the
Stromatopora, you have
alluded ^{to} in the February-
Number of the Annuals
of natural history.

If you may, I shall
send you specimens
of the new Rhizopod

from Mauritius.
