Dear Sir

I again take the liberty of sending a few slides for your acceptance. In the Microscopical examination of the contents of "Boulder Clay" from various localities I occasionally find something that may be of interest to one as well posted as to their meaning, as you are and you so kindly referred to the findings in Minnesota clay that I hope slides showing more abundant and richer forms in clay from Lincoln Co. Nebraska will not be unacceptable. I also find in this clay a few of your organisms & have marked one with Mutwood.
