My Dear Sir

Can you find it  
convenient to examine the three  
sections of fossil wood which I send  
by the same mail and inform me  
whether the structure is familiar  
to you. This is from the Styliola  
layer of the Genesee shales in  
Ontario co. N. Y. from which  
I have previously sent you  
material, and the structure, to  
my uninitiated eye appears  
to be different from that of  
Dadoxylon. During the last few years

I have gathered considerable new material representing these fossil woods, much of it indeed apparently similar to the *D. advoynum* described by you from these rocks, but whether identical or not I am unable to say. Should you feel inclined to investigate them I shall be glad to place them at your disposal
