specimens of Stroma Concentrica. They were  
sent to myself a short  
time ago. They present  
peculiarities of structure  
such as I have not  
seen before. Of course  
I may be in error as  
to their specific character,  
but generally they

are undoubtedly strom-  
atopoid.

In one specimen, an immense number of small tubes seem to penetrate the various laminae — these have <sup>not</sup> the appearance of oscula, but are more like what we see in a cross section of *Pyrosopora*. I shall not attempt to describe them further than simply to say that I <sup>think</sup> they are very peculiar. I merely write to refer them to you for examination

if you so desire. I  
shall be most happy  
to forward them to you  
at once for that pur-  
pose.
