



Montreal July 29 1876

Dear Sir

Your letter of 20th with
enclosures came to hand this
morning and we have posted
to Cook your letter after having
placed a money order for \$50.00
in the envelope.

There will be a duty of 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ %
to pay upon the Microscopes which
with exchange and freight so
will bring the cost up to 50%
calculated in currency.

We would propose to sell them
at \$52 - and \$40 - We observe
that Cook make it a condition
that our draw should be
taken at a time. We suppose

there would be no difficulty in dis-
posing of so many. Your recommend-
ation would we presume apply to
both instruments
