My dear Dr. Dawson

just yet. We hope however



that we shall be able to go

My wife has had a letter from  
Mrs Armstrong who makes no  
allusion to a possible or probable  
resignation, but speaks of her  
father's health as if it were very  
precarious - This is not  
unlikely to be the case.
