Dear Dr. Sawson

Since my return home I have made further enquiry regarding the discovery of copper ore at Lochaber, and find I was correct as to the situation. It is about a mile West in a direct line from the South end of Lochaber Lake. The first lode was about 4 feet thick, and another has been discovered about six feet. I send you small specimens, and if you would like larger I can easily get them. I send also a notice from the Eastern Chronicle of a still later discovery of what is said to be native copper.

Would you be kind enough to
look in your father's memoranda, and
see if there are any notices of the for-
mation of the first Temperance
society in Pitou Town. He was actively
engaged in it. If there are please forward
any information you may find.
