While at the Centennial I saw the admirable "Reports of the Geological Survey of Canada", and among them your reports on "Fossil Plants of the Lower Carboniferous & Middle Grit" 1873, & "Fossil Plants of Devonian and Upper Silurian, 1871". All of the reports are extremely desirable but in this one I am most interested.

A few years ago I made a collection more or less valuable, of the fossil plants found in the coal measures in Mahoning Co., Eastern Ohio, and a little more than a year ago I became much interested in making similar collections from the Cannel Coal Bank near Darlington, Pa., and made drawings

in India but of a few of them, but was pre-
vented from continuing my search very long
by business duties. I was unable to find
any work giving description of several of
the specimens I found. Dana's *Biology* not
being sufficient. In your work, which I
had only time to glance at, I saw several
of the plants etc. I found, described & illustrated
and I should like very much to obtain a
copy of it, if it is possible to do so, &
would, of course, willingly pay all charges
for the same. If you can inform me
on this subject I shall be under
many obligations
