up with the Carboniferous
Corals, that, it has been out
of my power to do anything
with them. I hope soon, either

personally a curiosity to
have them described, and
figured. I have also delayed
reproducing microscopic
sections, till I had completed
an application to my mic-
roscope, by which means
I hope to be able to repro-
duce faithful similes of the
most delicate structure,
and if successful, will
have the structural details
engraved upon copper plates,
by the same method, that
I do my crabs, (which is new)
so soon as any of the forms

have been described. I will
be delighted to forward
you the results.
