my own knowledge or any benefit
it may be to the public

Please notice in collection one
large flower something like a sunflower
turned bottom ~~side~~ up attached to
a piece of rock the bottom shut in
quarry just above the fire clay
and coal also on joint of a fish
bone or Reptile found about ten feet
from surface, above stone Reef
it came down when men were carrying
garris but know from the colour
the shaly rock it was imbedded in
which is the depth above mentioned
