My Dear Sir.

Allow me to thank you for the note on Post, Phiscon Fossils. I have some good specimens of corals, which I will be happy to give you, and I must ask a little time as I am very much occupied, I fear I will not be able to send you any until after Christmas when I hope to get time for work.

Mr. Walcott (Prof. Hall's Assistant) has sent three tons of corals home from Ontario, and before he collected ten tons in New York state. If many such geologist come around they will be more destructive than all the demanding agencies from the Mississippi to the Yukon.

The gentleman is now here collecting. Any specimens of the Carboniferous or sub-Carboniferous that you will be able to spare will be thankfully received.
