Last January I wrote to you and one or two others in relation to fossils from the Trenton and other Lower Silurian formations, but all say they have none and refer me to you. I will thank you for the information, if the facilities are very good for collecting at the localities of the Quebec Group. There are so many collectors that I am doubtful if it would pay for me to make a trip, as the localities may have been worked recently. I need material very much from the Quebec, Blk A. & Calciferous. I am making the Lower Silurian formations a special study and my collection of Hudson River, <sup>and</sup> Trenton of this State is very large and complete. The Calciferous of this State and the St. Johns Group of N.B. I also have a good representation of, but I wish to secure a good series from the Quebec & other formations of Canada. I would like a good specimen of *Cozoon Canadense* for study and will you please inform me when I can obtain a good specimen. I cannot
