I will take pleasure in having the name of Robert L. Jack, put on the distribution list of the Smithsonian Institution.

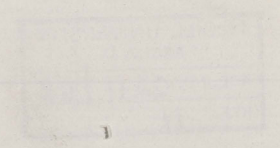
