

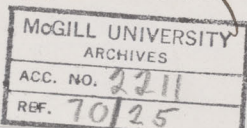

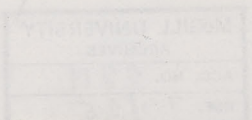
My Dear Dr Dawson:
