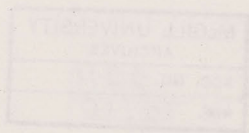
I hope to be able to prepare at least a synopsis of the changes which I would suggest in the Education Bill; of course they would represent simply my own views, and will not in any way
