I sent you about July 1st a number of the Review containing one of these articles & I hand you here with proof of another.

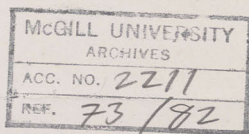
I do not like to trouble you but will be very glad indeed if you will inform me (not for publication without your permission) whether or not Mr McWhirters statements are correct in regard to these articles
