*Calamites gigas*.

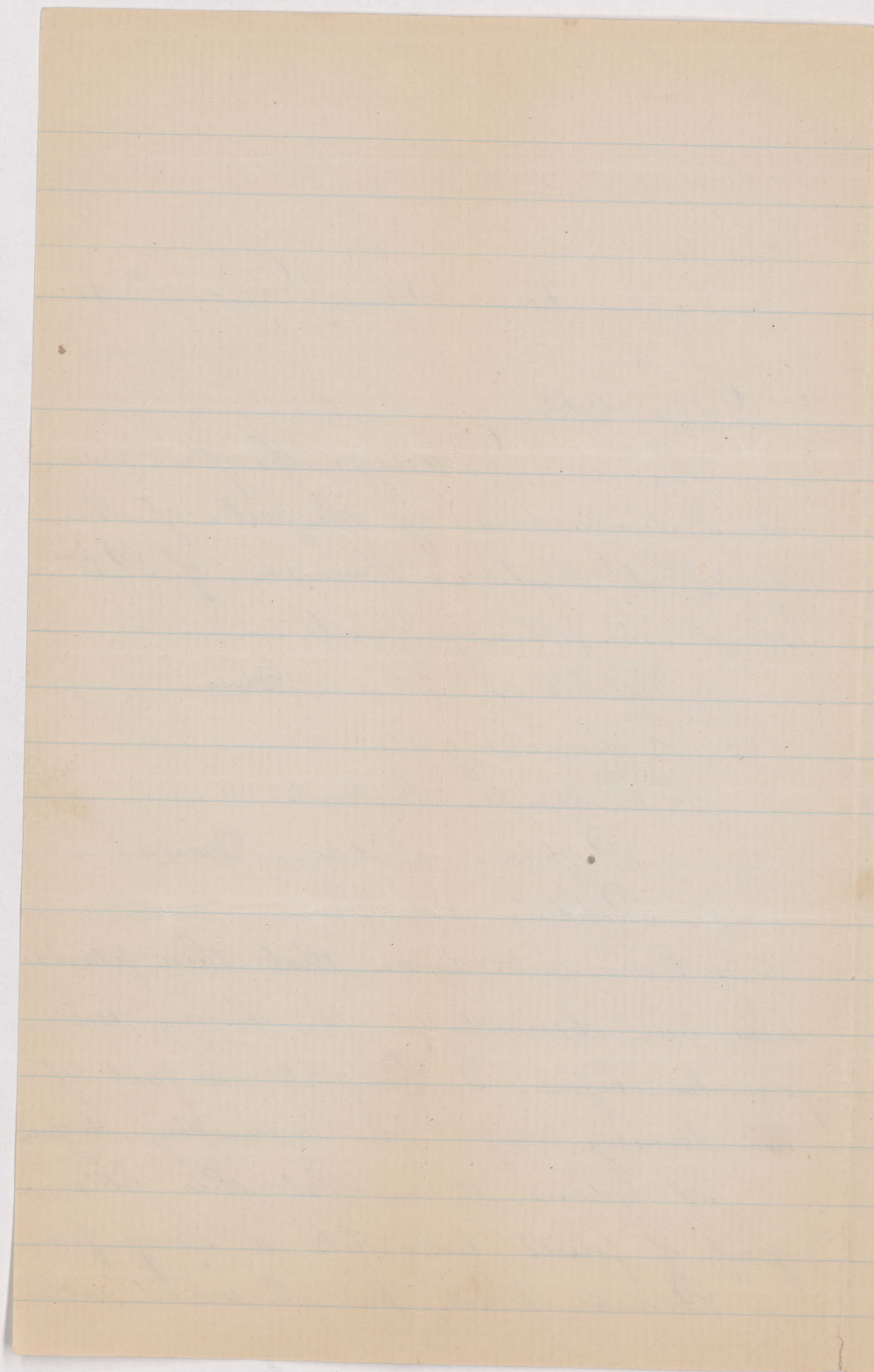
*Calamites Suckowii*.
