paid five cents.

I understand the difficulties
as to ownership of the Polsons
Lake Copper areas have been ar-
ranged - all the areas being
united in one interest which
is held in equal shares of one
half each by the Ross McLean
party and the other half by the
New Glasgow people and others
who disputed the lease to Ross.

Each party has appointed three
Directors a majority of whom are
authorized to conduct operations
and to sell at their discretion.

I hope they may be able to do
something with it during the
coming summer.
