

Pilot Ground, 20th Jan 1882,

Dear Sir,

I send you today a fossil that I found at this place. I searched several times for fossil remains in the Peubria valley. The spot where I found it is about eighty five miles west of Emerson and fifteen miles north of the International Boundary line.

Should you tell me what formation the specimen I send you belongs to I will consider it a great favor. Any specimens I may be fortunate enough to find I shall be only too happy to forward them to you.

myself to return to Wales
and take a full course of
study, but like many other
young men we caught the
Manitota fever, gave up
positions in the Perth
and Almonte High Schools
respectively, James held
the position of Inspector
of Schools for the City of
Ottawa last year.
