I enclose herewith the
revise proof of two pp. of Lecture First.
It seems to me that the first sentence on
p. 38 might be made more clear, the only
one that I have found in the Ms. after
going through it all carefully. You will
also notice that in order to avoid a
broken line at the top of p. 39 it leaves
p. 38 a line short. This I do not like to see
at any time. To fill out this line perhaps you
could elongate the latter part of the para-
graph, or the modification of the first
sentence might accomplish the same end.

The first word of notes on the first cut,
the Amphioxus, I cannot decipher. It
is something "or rudimentary" &c. All else
is legible. If any word should be mis-
constructed, the designed word will fill

An equal space in the proof & it can
be corrected there.

If you will return the proof with
amendment & enlargement as soon
as possible I shall be much obliged.

Monday. In locating the cuts I
simply put in the page in parentheses
(See Plate!) &c The printer will put
the plate page in the best relative
