I understand from Mr. Wilton that you have in the Museum connected with McGill University a large collection of Mollusca - specimens of Marine Life that I find we have much difficulty in obtaining for a complete Canadian Exhibit at the Great International Fisheries Exhibition to be held in London next year. If you have such a Collection would the Governors and Faculty of the University be willing to send such, or any other specimens relating to our Fisheries, to London, as an exhibit from the University; or if not convenient for the Governors to undertake the trouble and expense of forwarding the Collections, would they allow them to be taken in charge by the Government and represented as part of the Canadian



Exhibit - under the immediate charge of
the Department?

far as possible, in remedying this,
at present, defective part of our con-
templated Exhibit.
