(Zittel, Schwager, &c. - on the Libyan

In vol. x. pp. 195 &c. You will find
some account also of Ehrenberg's
signed specimens from the Upper
Missouri & the Upper Mississippi.
I am sorry that I have ^{no} separate copies
of these papers (by Parker & myself) left

a copy about December 1872 -
according to a note of distribution
that I have by me. -

I think, also, that I have mentioned
by letter to you or to Dr. S. M. Dawson
that by our system of nomenclature
his Textularia globulosa (p. 253, fig. a, in

Tectularia striata, Ehr. (or T. gibbosa, Döb., var
striata), his fig. ~~57~~⁵⁸ Planorbulina
ammouoides, Reuss - both of them.

I forgot to mention last evening,
that I could supply good drawings of
your Canadian Paleozoic
Beurichia & other Entons, which
you have noticed in your works,
if you could get a good lithographic
artist to reproduce them, & good
furnish notes on them - by myself
& J. W. Kirby - If not in any
Canadian work, they might appear
in the Geol. Mag. or Annals Nat. Hist.
if the ^{drawings of the} plates were given - in
the case of the Geol. Mag. the printer too.
