My Dear Sir

About a year ago in answer to an inquiry about the Devonian fossils of Canada you kindly intimated a willingness to exchange duplicates of Canadian Palaeozoic fossils for those of other localities, at some future time when you would be better able to attend to it. Should you still be willing to do so I would be glad to receive from you a list of what you prefer to get first, or most need. I am now better able than ever before to furnish good examples of a large number of species having lately purchased the collection accumulated by Prof. Lesquereux during the past 30 years, that contains a considerable number of types and typical specimens which when added to my own will release some previously selected to be kept. I expect Prof. Lesquereux to spend most of June and July with me and the advantage of his assistance in giving you typical examples would add to their value for use in comparisons.
