My dear Sir William,

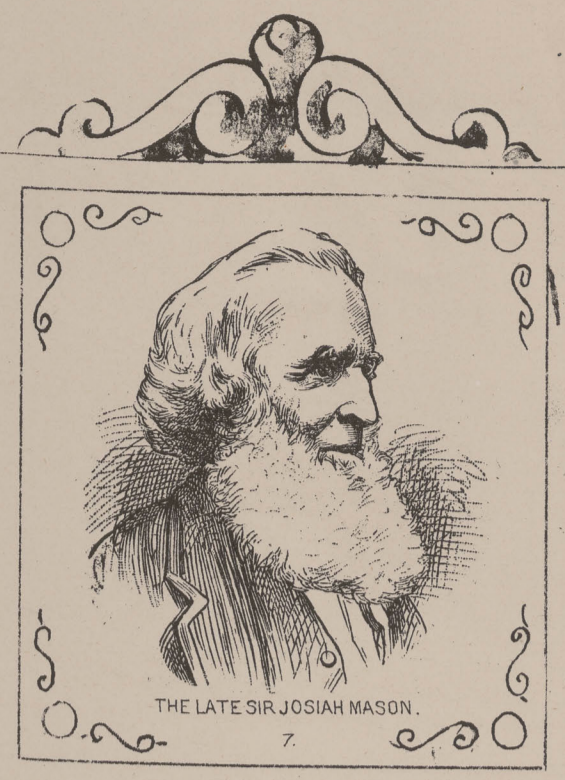

his statements are unanswerable.

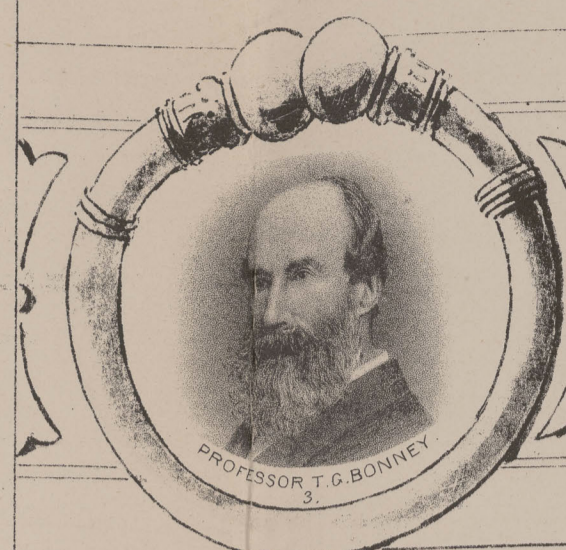
