Dear Sir,

As requested I sent up my fore-  
man to examine the roof of your  
house on University St and reports  
that the flat portion of it is in a bad  
condition; seams cracked and a good  
many of the Tin plates perforated by  
rust. The tops of the Windows require  
also considerable repairs. I would  
not think it advisable to attempt to  
repair this flat portion, but recom-  
mend its being re-covered with  
galvanized Iron.

To do so with No 28 gal Iron, furnishing  
a new coping of gal Iron at  
the intersection of the slope roof with  
the flat, recover scuttle, or man hole,  
with the same material and repairing  
the tops of Windows, would cost the  
sum of \$71.<sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub>

We have already replaced a few slates that  
were required. Having your further
