Dear Sir W. Dawson

I hope you will let

get some local geologist  
to meet you here -

If you cannot arrive  
till the Friday, you  
might still see the  
Porcelain Works &  
possibly the Museum  
on that day; but  
the works certainly, over  
which I will go with

you; & then you might  
come here for lunch  
& a long drive round  
the hills on the 21<sup>st</sup>

I was so sorry I  
was not at the  
Oxford & Cambridge  
then you called. I  
walked back from  
the horse soon after  
& found your card.

The "local museum"  
at Worcester, which forms  
one room of the general  
museum, contains a very  
fair representation of the  
natural history of our  
county. It was begun by  
my father, & completed  
under my own care -
