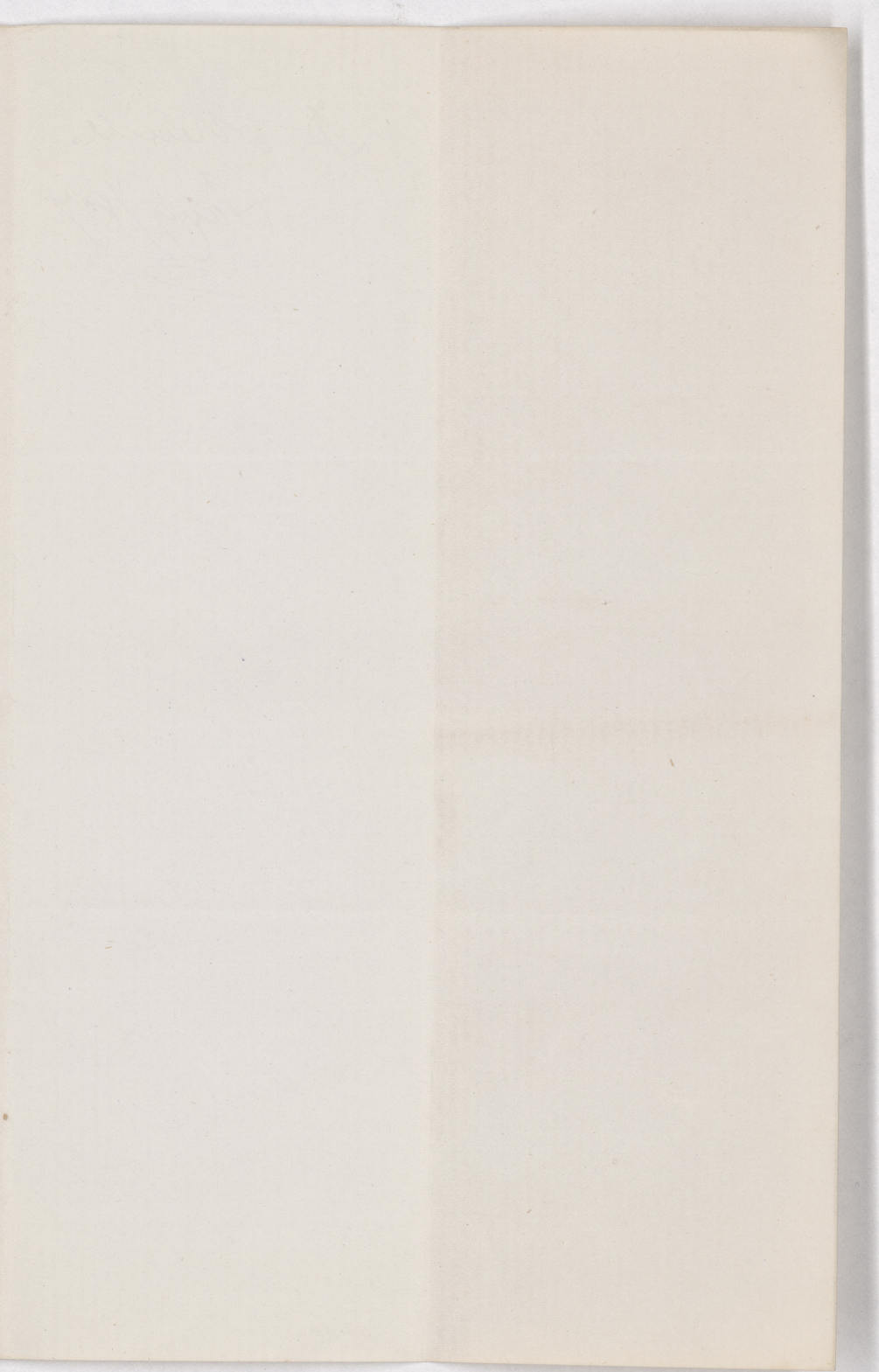
DEAR DR DAWSON.
