Mr Weston has made some sketches of the blackish
 py limst on yr so called upst area east of Lennoxville
 but I send you a few figures uncorrected by work in the
 day the past two seasons, other things to be not upst but
 the same as in the Burlington rocks. The upst being in
 very limited patches. The discovery completely changes
 the entire Colony. Of the top end of Lennoxville to the
 boundary of Massena is all that Vermont & New
 Hampshire. Some time ago I doubt not the same area
 defined all seem to the eastern boundary of the Province
 Mr Weston thinks he has been yr Salisbury in some of
 the sketches -
