I have mailed to your address to-day a copy of the *Manitoba Medical Register*, which has just been printed for distribution among the members of the College.

You will notice by reference to the by-laws therein contained that the annual fee for the current year, beginning 13th October, 1886, has been fixed at \$3.00. It was considered that under ordinary circumstances \$2.00 would constitute a sufficient revenue, but that in consequence of the extra expense entailed in the publication of the Register and other incidental outlays in connection therewith, it would be necessary to impose a fee of \$3.00 for this year.

The Council have decided to vigorously prosecute all unqualified practitioners throughout the Province, and with that end in view you are hereby requested to send to the Registrar any information you may possess in reference to any such person or persons in your neighborhood.
