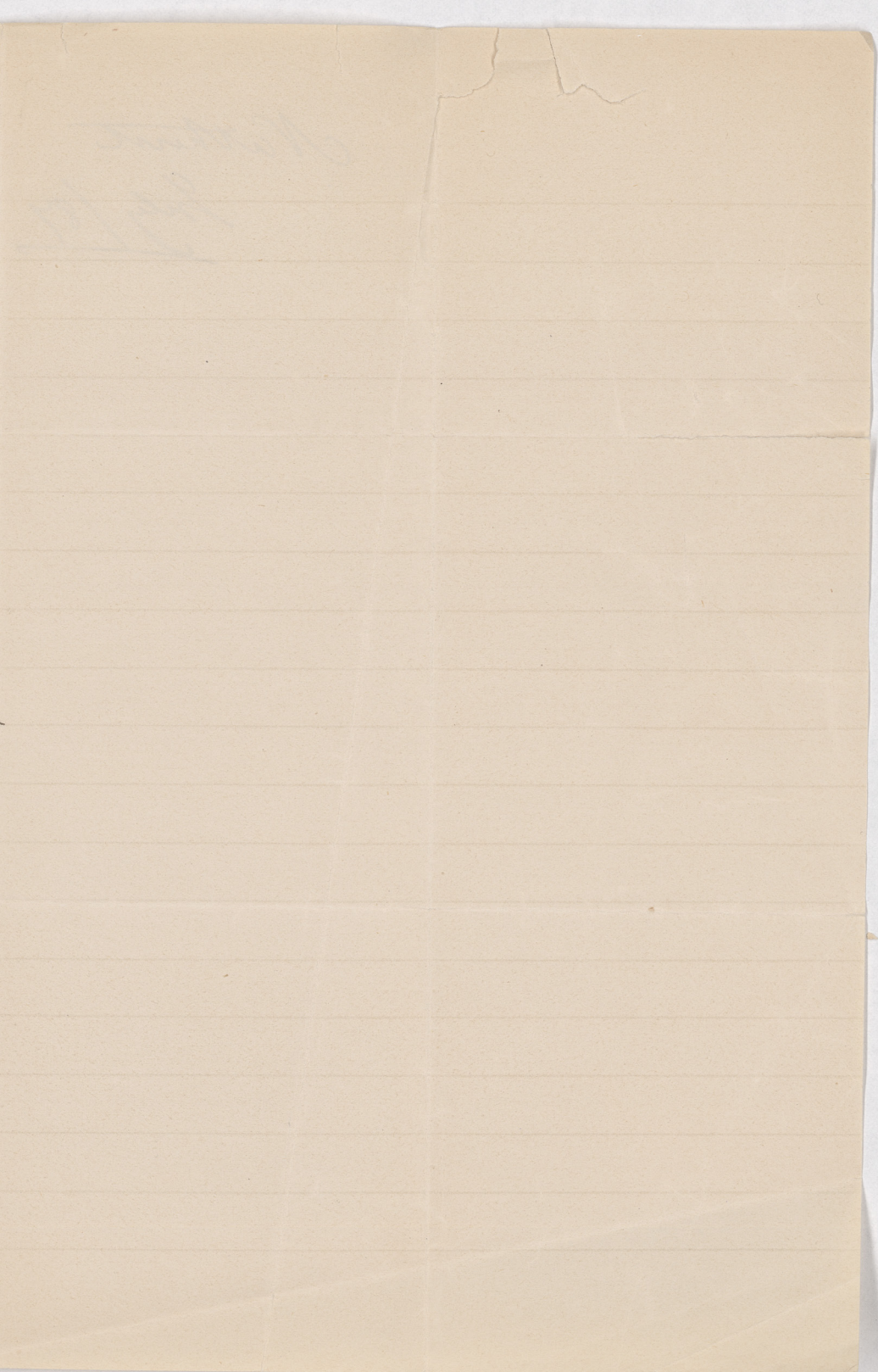
The leaf-scars are quite agreeing however with those of *Lepidodendron tetragonum*, but ~~as~~ I will

compare the specimen with  
your *Leptophleum rhombicum*  
when I come back to  
town again.

I am at present over the  
campaign but will be  
in Stockholm again within  
some weeks. I was  
glad to see from your  
letter that the stratigraphi-  
cal position of the Psilo-  
phyton-bearing beds on Spitz-  
bergen seems to be the  
same as in Canada.
