I write to you
now and asking you whether
it will be possible for you
to give two lectures in the
Presbyterian Church at Ann
Arbor to the students of the
University of Michigan on some

let you know frankly, whether

all so anxious to have you
address the students in our
Presbyterian lecture course for
their benefit. I earnestly trust
that this year we may have
you presented at Ann Arbor
on a Sabbath day for these
two lectures. Sabbath is the
only day available for them.
Should you consent to come,
we would also arrange for at
least one lecture in Detroit
on a Sunday topic. So please
include that in your estimate
of the sum you will expect.
