The name St. Louis
Series I have never used

 St Jerome seem to
 have a great thickness
 and to overlie the
 regular gneiss series.
 These are I suppose the
 real Upper Laurentian
 of that particular locality,
 with or without the
 great beds ^{masses} of anorthitic
 & talciferite which you
 have so well exposed,
