The Com^{tee} advised with both these brethren with regard to the propriety of sending a catechist there for the summer Both advised not to do so now as there is a probability of a change in the rectorate of the Episcopal Church and if an evangelical man comes all the people will accept him - We are asking the Board of French Evangelization to send an English-French missionary who while doing work among the French can look after the interests of our people - or rather the

English Speaking people
many of whom were
once ours but have be-
come Episcopalian through
long neglect on our part.

This is all we can do
in the mean time - I
will have the money ex-
pended in good books here
and forwarded to our teach-
ers for distribution ^{among} the
Sabbath Schools.
