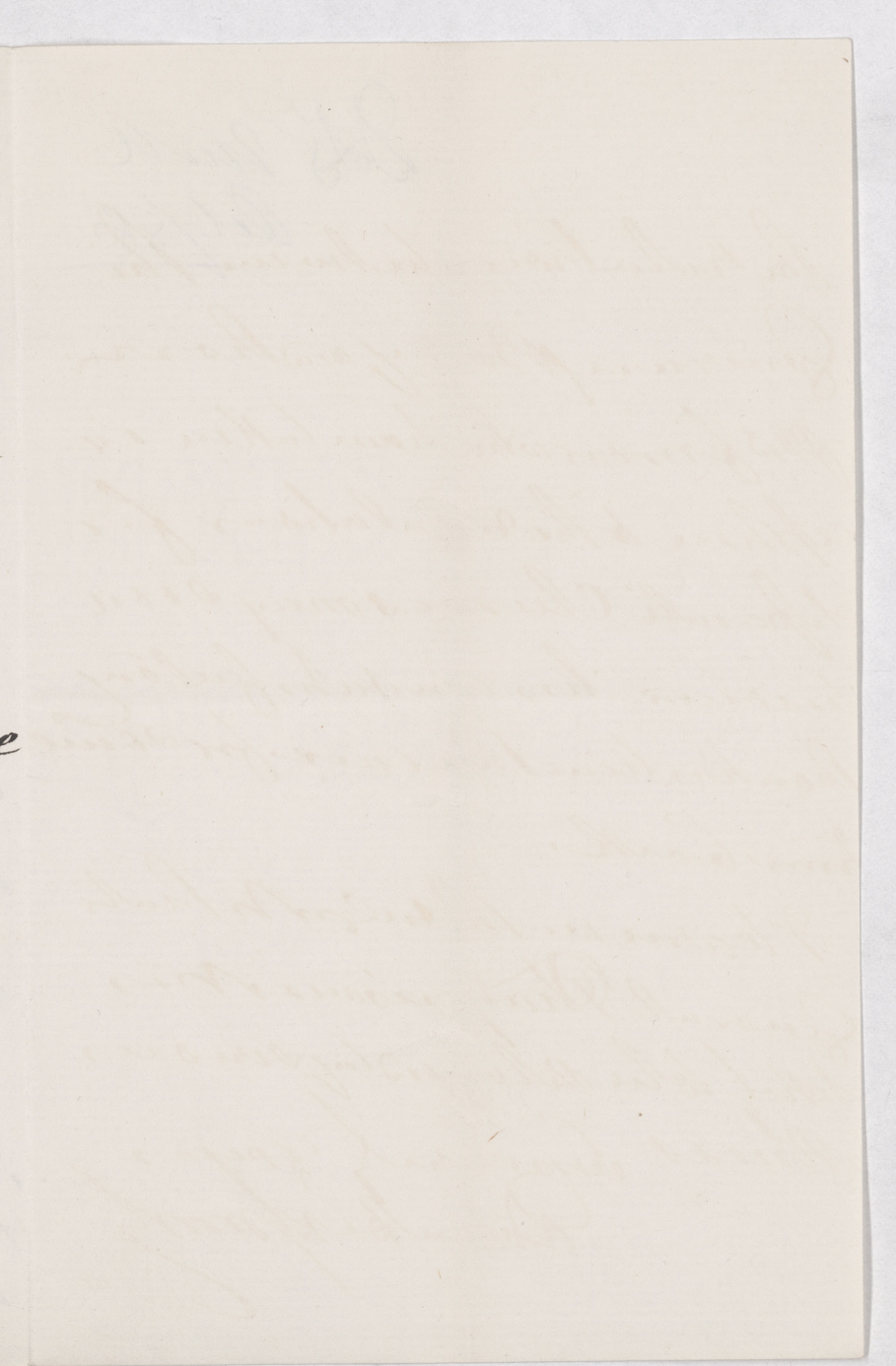
Dear Mr Mann,
