Addressing a Senate Committee on Interstate Commerce on May 7, Mr. Chauncey Depew is reported as having said: "The only reason the United States permitted a line so advantageous to Canada to be built along the boundary was that there was no apprehension of Canada in America. The majority of the people looked upon it as a ripening plum, ready to drop into their hat."

It is alleged that much mischief has arisen from the public expression of irresponsible opinion upon this subject, and that international comity is thereby endangered.
