I can only say now that I have abundant evidence to prove that these mammals and the

gigantic Ceratopsidae which  
are found with them are  
Cretaceous. Their affinities  
are rather with Jurassic  
forms than Tertiary.  
The transition forms to  
the latter are yet to be  
found in higher beds.

I agree with you that the so  
called "Saramie" is mixed up  
by various geologists in this  
country. I hope soon to  
do something toward clearing  
up the matter.
