Sir,

I have the honour to direct your special attention to the following Rules of the Society:

PAPERS.

The title of any Paper, Memoir or other production, by a member, intended to be read at a meeting of the Society, shall be submitted, together with an abstract of its contents, to the Council, through the Secretary, previous to the meeting at which it is to be read. * * *
No paper shall be read in any section, at any general meeting of the Society, unless it has been presented, *either in full or in abstract, at least three weeks before the first day of the meeting*, and formally accepted by the Council, in accordance with Rule X of the Society, except by special permission of the Council. The publication of any paper not so accepted, as having been read before or presented to it, may be disavowed by the Society.

The Ninth General Meeting of the Royal Society will be held in the City of Ottawa on Tuesday, 27th day of May next.
