THE JUNIOR DEPARTMENT—including separate accommodation for the Religious, Social and Physical Work for Boys. This is most important.

The Board of Directors have decided to erect the Building according to the "Original" Plan. To accomplish this, the Building Committee require the financial co-operation of Merchants, Manufacturers, Citizens, and the young of the City, and all who are interested in this special work.
