I go by Northern Pacific to Portland Oregon & will return by Canadian Pacific. we will be 5 or 6 weeks away from home, say until 15 Sept. Mr McDonald is out of town but will be back about the time I am leaving.

I hoped to take this journey the last two seasons, but it never seemed quite convenient so I determined to make a

desperate effort and go, or I should
never get away, so I am off
or nearly so. I am sorry to go
during Mr Finleys absence,
but Mr McDonald will I hope
be willing to do whatever may
be necessary.

had left before I called to see
