The observation on Prof. Hughes' specimen of Frugiana is pretty well covered by his alteration of words in the Discussion -

|| Buthotrephis Grantii, fig. 17 (from Photograph), at p. 604, is stated to be from the "Niagara Formation" & B. Grantii, fig. 16 (wood cut), p. 613, is stated to be from the "Silurian of Canada" - of course we cannot ^{by insertion} state now which is from "Hamilton, Ontario," and I presume it is not of much consequence. If I had got Linnaeus's reference all right already. || We could not properly refer to an unpublished vol. of Roy. Soc. Canada, or any other book. - I found enough in the Amer. Journ. Sci. to complete your reference & to get the right spelling of "Aminithia" - I trust that you will find the Paper all right now. We should have got little credit in omitting references, & full references too, where practicable -

I have told the Printers to pack carefully seven bound books & send them with the ²⁰⁰ separate copies to the Geol. Soc. (as usual & required) - & then they will ^{all} be forwarded to you.

Some of my late papers on fossil Articulata are ready
