I have read with lively interest these reminiscences of your career, marked by so many important undertakings which have been satisfactorily accomplished during the period of your connection with education in this Province.


Like all that comes from your pen your narration has enough of strength and life to give an additional charm to the attractiveness of your career as an educationist.
