Dear Sir William

Your note received advising that you were sending your resignation of your place as member of the Council of Public Instruction at Quebec

I am sorry you have found it necessary to retire after so long and faithful a stewardship, but if <sup>it</sup> has to be, we cannot help it and can only thank you for all you have done in the cause of protestant education

I have written to Mr Tailor using the name of the University which I suppose was proper to do.

Regarding the Museum fund which I have contributed to in the past, I will still do so, but perhaps not to the same extent, as I am not now familiar with its necessities as I was before
