(2) If not, where do you place the responsibility for their inefficiency and what do you suggest as a practical remedy for the same ?

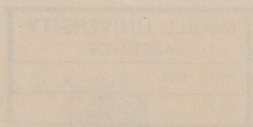


