My dear Sir

Two or three days since I sent up to the Museum of the College a series of specimens illustrating the smelting of copper to a regulus or matte. The samples are from the Capel Mine Lennoxville and consist of

1. Undressed pieces of ore assaying from 10% to 15% copper. These are more than average samples.
2. Dressed ores (broken to a convenient size for roasting) all the small pieces come under this head.
3. Roasted ore. The sulphur is partially driven off and the iron oxidized. The roasting is in heaps in the open air.
4. Regulus or matte containing over 40% copper. This is the state in which it comes from the furnace, and in which it is shipped.
5. Slag. This contains less than $\frac{5}{10}$ % of copper. The other

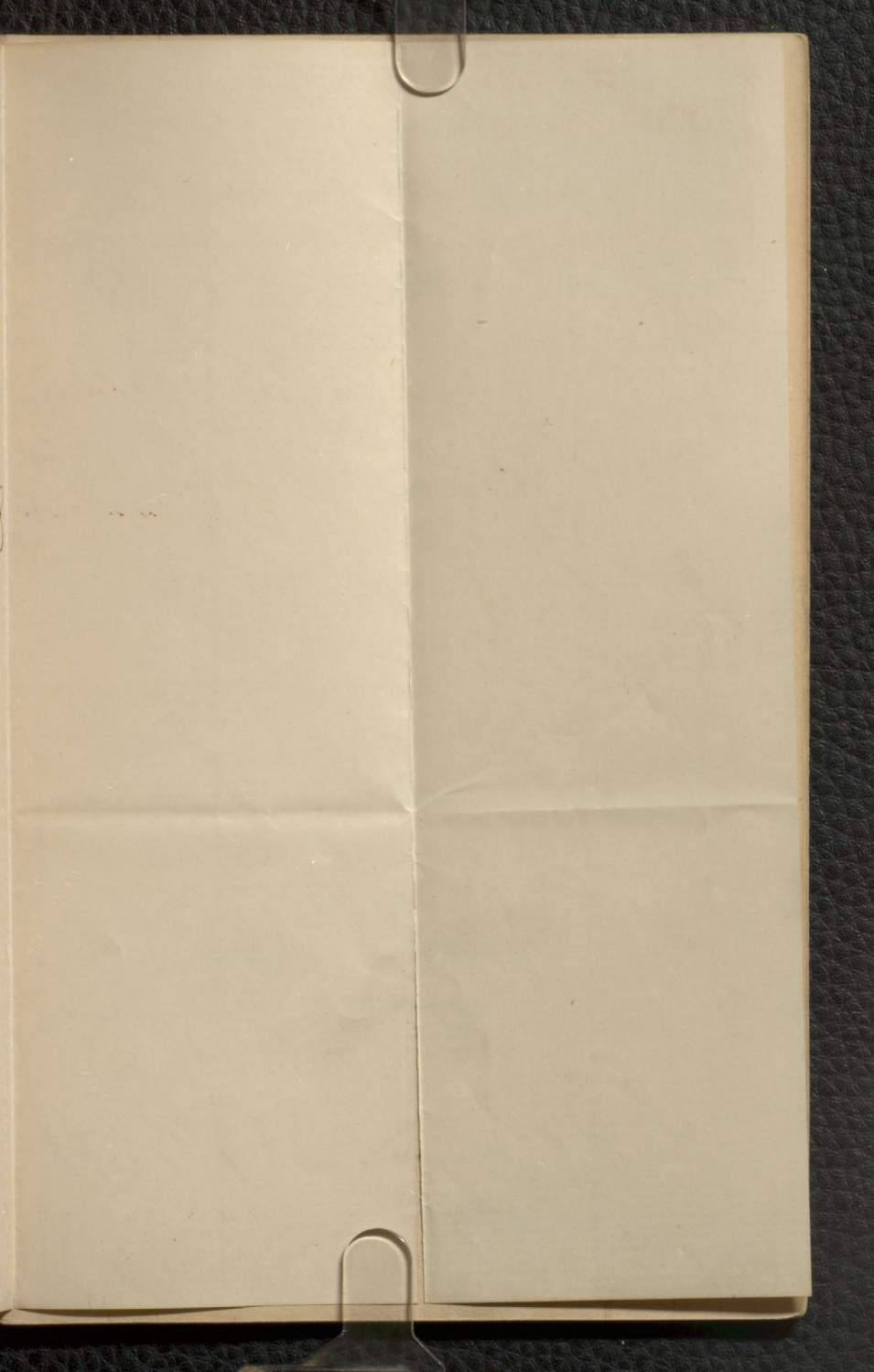

UNIVERSITY INTELLIGENCE.

At the regular meeting of the Corporation of McGill University, held on Wednesday, the 28th of October, the Vice-Chancellor having stated that he had been desired by Mrs. Redpath, of Terrace Bank, to intimate to the Corporation her willingness to give the sum of one hundred dollars annually during her pleasure: as an exhibition in the Faculty of Arts, to be competed for annually by students of the third year, and to be tenable for one year only—the examination to be general in all the subjects of the course, it was

Resolved,—That the liberal offer of an exhibition of one hundred dollars in the Faculty of Arts, by Mrs. Redpath, be, and hereby is, accepted by this Corporation, on the conditions proposed, subject to the approval of the Board of Governors, and that the same be designated “The Jane Redpath Exhibition.”

That the cordial thanks of this Corporation be conveyed to Mrs. Redpath for her very reasonable and useful donation.

That the Faculty of Arts be authorized to make arrangements for offering the exhibition for competition in the present session, and to prepare the necessary regulations for the same, reporting to the Corporation at its next meeting.

The Vice-Chancellor informed the Corporation that since the last meeting, the bust of His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales, executed by Mr. Marshall Wood, of London, had been placed in the Library of the University by William Molson, Esq., to whose liberality the University is indebted for the possession of this valuable work of art and memorial of the visit of the Prince. It was

Resolved,—That the Corporation, in accepting from William Molson, Esq., his gift to the College of the bust of His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales, executed by Mr. Marshall Wood, tender to him the cordial thanks of the University; and they cheerfully accede to the request that this work of art be placed in the Hall erected by the munificence of the donor. Further, they order that a suitable inscription be placed on the pedestal to record this further exercise by Mr. Molson of his liberality towards the College.”

McGILL UNIVERSITY.

A donation has lately been made to the University Museum, of one of the first series of the great Reigen collection of Mazatlan Shells. The original series, described by Dr. P. P. Carpenter in the British Museum catalogue, was presented to the National Collection; but before appropriating any specimens for his own or any other private collection, he selected four principal series, corresponding as nearly as possible, table for table, with that in the British Museum. These were destined for the principal Free Museums in America, France, Germany and Russia. The first (at the instance of Dr. Newcomb, now of San Francisco,) was presented to the New York State Museum at Albany, and arranged there by Dr. C. in 1859. The other three, having been declined by the European governments on the conditions proposed, were offered to the Cambridge Museum of Comparative Zoology, to the University of McGill College, and to the Smithsonian Museum. These were at once accepted on the conditions named; viz.: that they should be preserved, separate and intact, for the free use of students; and that Dr. C. should be enabled to arrange them according to the plan of the British Museum collection. The expenses attendant on this arrangement has been defrayed in the case of the McGill College collection by the liberality of Mrs. G. Frothingham, of Montreal, and the collection will soon be available for the use of the students. The true value of this series consists not in the mere fact of its presenting to the eye between 3,000 and 4,000 of the tropical shells of the Gulf of California, eliminated from the careful comparison of many myriads; but in the selection being made by the author of the standard work on the subject, to explain his own book. As the shells will be fastened on glass tablets with the corresponding book-numbers, students in succeeding generations will always be able to identify the species thus illustrated; and a vast amount of uncertainty and error will be prevented, which has attended the use of other manuals in which the authors have not had an opportunity of duplicating their types in different countries.

The last census shows that the population of the city of New York proper had increased only 96,000 in ten years—standing low at 726,000. In ten out of the twenty-two wards there had been a decrease of population. It will thus be seen that New York is coming more and more "to live out of town."
